Section 2. <u>Immunity</u>. To the fullest extent allowed by law, both as now in effect and as hereafter adopted or amended, each present and future Officer (and his or her estate, heirs, and personal representatives) shall be immune from suit arising from the conduct of the affairs of the Association.

ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

The Association may be dissolved only with authorization of its Executive Committee given at a special meeting called for that purpose and with subsequent approval by no less than two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members.
